CARSEAT SAFETY

On Tuesday, the Horizons Regional Council Road Safety Primary School Restraint Education Programme took place at school. The aim of this programme is to educate children and families about the importance of being harnessed safely in a car seat. By law, all children under the age of 7 years need to be in a car seat, however, it is far safer if children remain in a car seat until they are 148 cms tall. Brooklyn (see picture below) is measuring himself against the safety chart. Desley Monks (Horizons - see picture below), Sarah Cree (NZ Police) and a number of Police and support personnel came along to assist on the day. Children also got to have a Police Officer safely strap them into the Police car.
