### TE TIPU - WALKER LEARNING APPROACH

Over the last 7 months we have welcomed visitors from around the country to our Te Tipu Suite. As you are aware every 5 year old entering Lytton Street School starts off as a 'seedling' in this amazing new facility. The Te Tipu teachers have worked hard to provide an engaging, rich and open plan environment where children can transition seamlessly from Early Childhood Education to school. The teachers work collaboratively together to provide learning opportunities that cater for each child's interests and needs. We have a wonderful group of teachers who nurture and extend children's creativity, thinking and skill development.

Our Te Tipu Suite has embraced the Walker Learning Approach since the beginning of the year. This approach was developed by Kathy Walker after decades of theory and research about child development, neuroscience and theories of play. It is based upon brain research, neuroscience, child development theory and the range of cultural and social influences from family and the wider environment. It is our aim to expand this effective approach school wide in 2015, although it will of course look different for differing age groups. Next week I shall add a further addition to this piece. Information about this approach is also being printed in our local newspaper.
