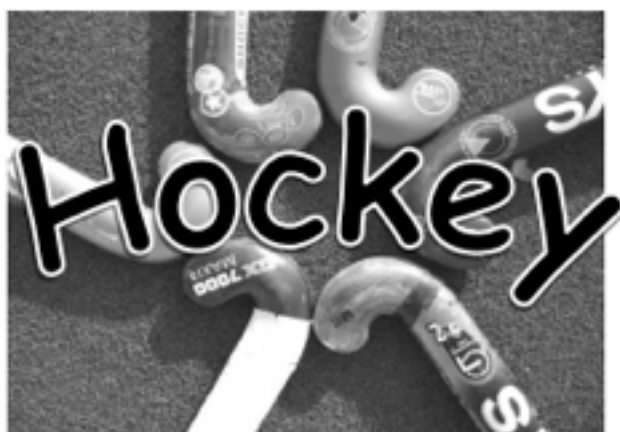
WELCOME
