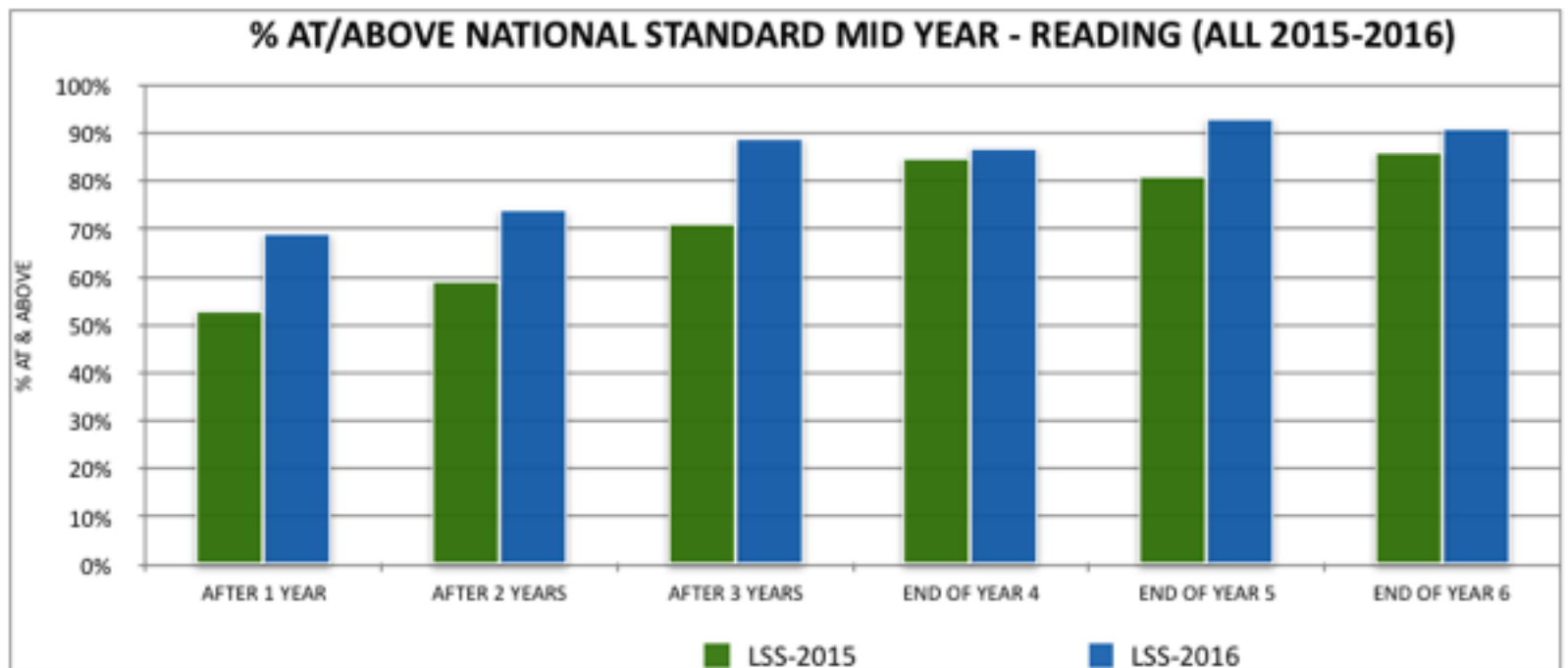


**MANAWATU TURBOS**

**STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT INFORMATION**

This report focuses on the predicted National Standards achievement data in Reading. Reading is an area of real strength for our students with most year groups achieving at least 70% At or Above the National Standard for their age. The data reflects a gradual improvement from a strong base of just under 70% in After 1 Year to almost 90% at the End of Year 6. In 2016 it is also great to see that our predictions are showing improvement across every age group.
