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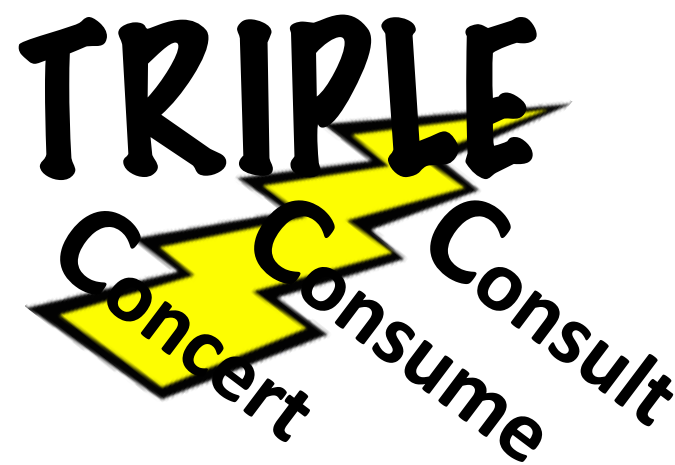

- Medication

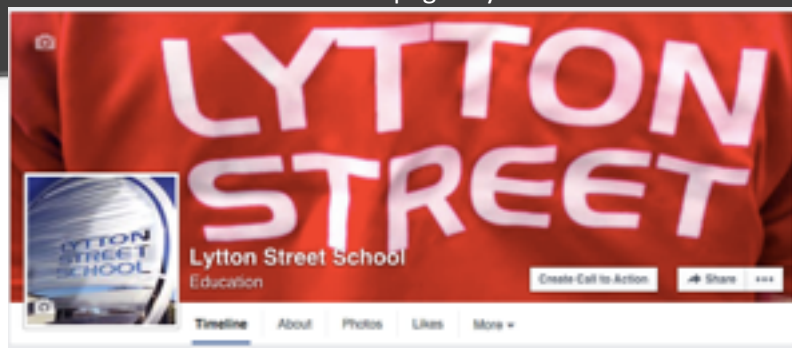
If your child requires an inhaler, please remind them to bring it on the day and hand it to their teacher.
