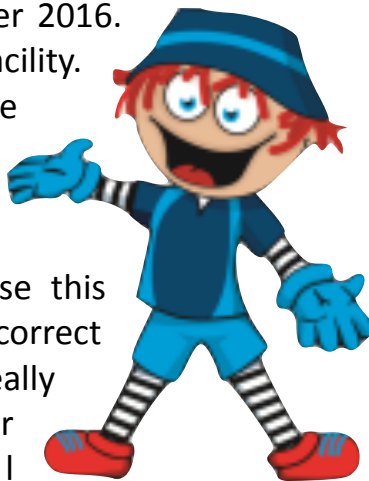


### QUIZ NIGHT

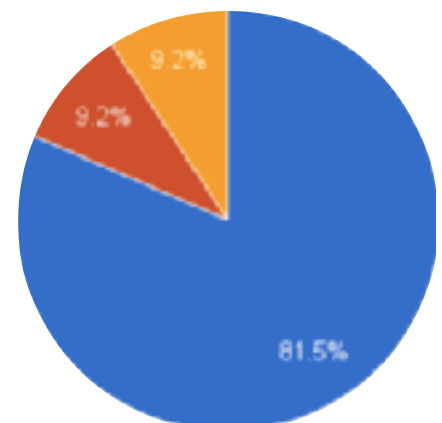
