Many thanks to the parents who attended the Whānau Hui on Tuesday night. Results and further information will follow shortly.

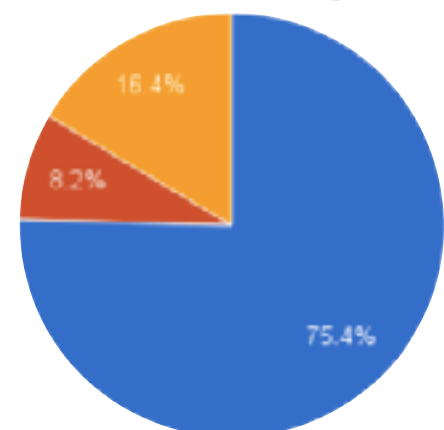
