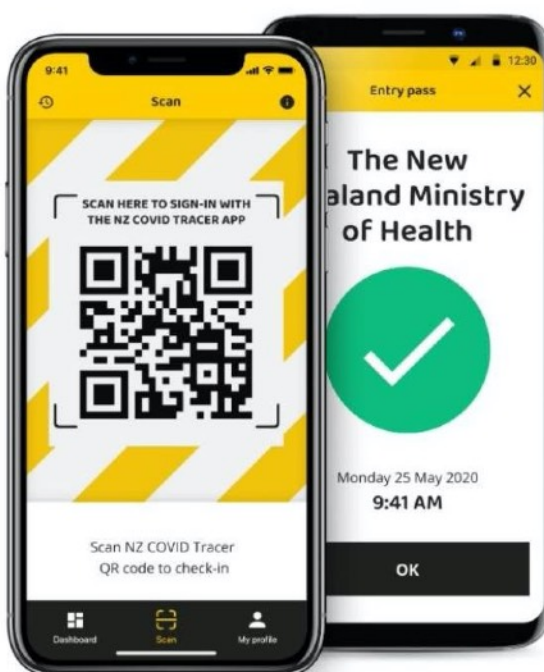


SUPPORT STAFF WEEK

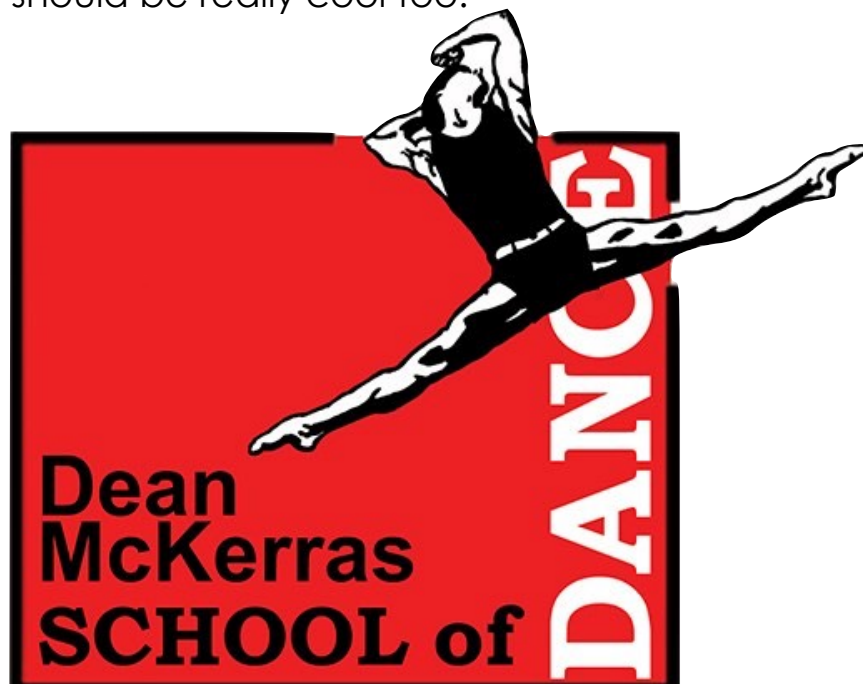


DEAN MCKERRAS SCHOOL OF DANCE
